Your dismissal from Jefferson was not rescinded after the entire appeal process. Your status remains that you are dismissed. The Committee on Student Promotions has determined that the dismissal would be reconsidered if the following 3 conditions are met:

Founded 1824

Jefferson Medical College

Jefferson College of Graduate Studies

Jefferson College of Health Professions

Jefferson University Physicians

1. You must have an independent psychiatric evaluation that finds you medically and psychiatrically stable to resume your medical studies. This must be done by an independent psychiatrist. Once chosen, this psychiatrist must contact Dr. Karen Glaser ([Karen.glaser@jefferson.edu](mailto:Karen.glazer@jefferson.edu); 215-955-0704) prior to your evaluation.

2. You enter into a contract with the Physicians Health Program and submit a copy of the contract to the Committee. The contact person is Mr. Greg Gable (866-747-2255). They may be able to provide you with a psychiatrist who can serve as the independent evaluator of your condition.

3. You agree to have your dean's letter modified to include your diagnosis of bipolar disorder and the accommodations that you requested to keep it under control. You will need to sign a letter agreeing to this.

If you meet the above conditions successfully, the Committee will rescind your dismissal and will prepare a remediation plan that will include a remediation of your Medicine sub-internship. The length of this remediation will be on the order of 6 months. If you are successful in completing the above, we will again meet to discuss any remediation plan arrived at by the Committee.

Some other items:

Email access: The current policy is that a student who is academically dismissed does not have student privileges at the university. This includes internet and email access. For communication purposes, your email and Banner access will be re-established.

Health insurance: Your current insurance will finish July 31, 2005. If you would like to purchase student health insurance, you must fill out the health insurance form and pay the \$2600 to the cashier's office. This is your responsibility.

Security: You will not have student access to the Jefferson campus. You will need prior authorization from the Office of Student Affairs and Career Counseling to be able to enter secured areas.

Please be aware that any unprofessional behavior on campus or in interactions with Thomas Jefferson University personnel may jeopardize your ability to be reinstated as a JMC student.
